In compliance with the provisions of Chapter 551, Texas Government Code, notice is hereby given of the first Public Hearing on Tax Increase of the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners of North Hays County Emergency Services District No. 1 to be held at North Hays County Emergency Services District #1 Building, 111 EMS Drive, Dripping Springs, Texas, 78620 at 5:00 p.m., September 5, 2019.

The following agenda items will be considered, and action taken as appropriate:

1. Call to order and establish a quorum.
2. Recognition of Citizens.
3. Citizen Comment* (Any individual may make a presentation relevant to the business of the District of not more than three (3) minutes to the Board of Emergency Services Commissioners, after executing the proper form, which may be obtained from the Secretary).
4. Consider taking action regarding 2019-2020 budget;
5. Conduct a public hearing on the proposal to increase property taxes;
6. Set and announce the date, time and place of the meeting to vote on the tax rate;
7. Authorize publication of the "Notice of Vote on Tax Revenue Increase" in the News-Dispatch or Dripping Springs Century News.
8. Adjourn.

*In accordance with the Texas Open Meetings Act, any response to a public comment that is made on an item that is not on the published final agenda will be limited to a statement of factual information or a statement of existing policy given in response to the public comment. Any deliberation or decision by the Board must be limited to a proposal to place the subject on a future agenda.

The Board may retire to Executive Session any time between the meeting's opening and adjournment for the purpose of consultation with legal counsel pursuant to Section 551.071 of the Texas Government Code; discussion of personnel matters pursuant to Section 551.074 of the Texas Government Code; discussion of real estate acquisition pursuant to Section 551.072 of the Texas Government Code and/or discussion of security personnel and/or security devices pursuant to Section 551.076 of the Texas Government Code. Action, if any, will be taken in open session.
