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1. Discuss construction project management contract with AGCM and take any related action.

DA Fowler presented a report on proposal by AGCM to provide services August, September, and October at no charge and then finishing out the year at \$11,314.00 per month. DA Fowler will contact Carlton about the legalities of extending the contract. This item was tabled until the August 15 meeting.

2. Discuss maintenance contracts with Stryker equipment and take any related action.

DA Fowler reported that having a contract with the Remi Group instead of Stryker would potentially save 25% in maintenance costs. After discussion, the following action was taken:

Commissioner Debish moved that we accept the Remi Group contract not to exceed \$14,000.00 and evaluate their services for a year. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Dement. Motion passed unanimously.

3. Consider taking action regarding the Fiscal Year 2023 budget.

After discussing the budget, the following action was taken:

Commissioner Dement moved to, understanding that there may be revisions to the budget in the future, accept the Fiscal Year 2023 budget as presented. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Debish. Motion passed unanimously.



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- 4. Discuss and consider action regarding the 2023 tax rate, including:
  - a. Establishing proposed tax rate.

After discussion, the following action was taken:

Commissioner Luddy moved that the property tax rate be increased by the adoption of a tax rate of \$0.0301 per \$100.00 valuation, which is effectively a 13.3% increase in the tax rate. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Dement. A record vote was taken, and the vote went as follows: Commissioner Lane- Aye Commissioner Luddy- Aye Commissioner Nelson- Aye Commissioner Debish- Aye Commissioner Dement- Aye Motion passed unanimously.

b. Taking record vote and scheduling public hearing; and

After discussion, it was decided that the public hearing would be August 15, 2023.

c. Authorizing publication of "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" in the Dripping Springs Century News, and

After discussion, the following action was taken:

Commissioner Luddy moved to publish last year's document of "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" modified with this year's numbers in the Dripping Springs Century News. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Debish. Motion passed unanimously.

d. Acknowledging and approving posting of "Notice About 2023 Tax Rates" and "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" to home page of District website

After discussion, the following action was taken:

Commissioner Dement moved to approve the posting of "Notice About 2023 Rates" and "Notice of Public Hearing on Tax Increase" to home page of District Website. 2<sup>nd</sup> by Commissioner Luddy. Motion passed unanimously.
